- Self attested photocopy of Mark sheet of Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination,
- Self attested photocopy of SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/PwD Certificate (wherever applicable),
- Domicile Certificate as per the prescribed format (Proforma a1 or a2 or b) as per guidelines of Govt. of West Bengal. (Click here to download the proforma). Domicile Certificate obtained from the West Bengal e-district portal (https://edistrict.wb.gov.in/PACE) will also be accepted as the proof of domicile.
- Declaration against ragging (Proforma to be downloaded from website).

The Admission fee of Rs. 13,770/- (Day scholar) and 20,870/- (Hosteller) for General, SC, ST, OBC-A & OBC-B candidates has to be deposited on the day of admission by cash through Bank-challan at Belgachia branch only of Union Bank of India located at University Campus. Candidates reporting after 11:45 A.M. will not be entertained.
