

THE UNIVERSITY

The West Bengal University of Animal & Fishery Sciences was established on January 2nd. 1995 by a Legislative Act (West Bengal University of Animal and Fishery Sciences Act- VI, 1995).

Prior to this, Veterinary education in the State was imparted by Bengal Veterinary College, a premier Institution of the country which was established in the year 1893. It was the 2nd oldest Veterinary College in the country and thereafter the College was expanded, enriched and functioned under Calcutta University until 1974. In 1974, the College was merged with Bidhan Chandra Krishi Viswavidyalaya situated at Mohanpur, District Nadia, as a Faculty of Veterinary and Animal Sciences.

Subsequently, during the centenary celebration of Bengal Veterinary College in 1993, it was felt to establish an independent Veterinary and Animal Sciences University to fulfill the needs of the State for promoting education, research and extension activities in the field of Veterinary and Animal Sciences including Fishery Sciences. Finally as per recommendation of an expert committee constituted by Government of West Bengal, the West Bengal University of Animal and Fishery Sciences was established in 1995 with its Headquarter at 68, K.B. Sarani, Belgachia, Kolkata- 700 037 in the former premises of Bengal Veterinary College. The University was inaugurated on May 31st, 1995 by Sri. Jyoti Basu, the then Hon'ble Chief Minister of West Bengal.

THE OBJECTIVES OF THE UNIVERSITY

- 1. To impart education in various branches of Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Dairy Technology and Fishery Sciences.
- 2. To promote basic and applied research in Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Dairy Technology and Fishery Sciences.
- 3. To undertake programmes of transfer of advanced technologies to improve Animal and Fish production.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMME

i) Minimum Requirement

The candidates for admission to Master's Degree Programme must have B.V.Sc. & A.H/ B.Tech. (Dairy Technology)/ B.F.Sc. from a recognized University with minimum 55% marks in aggregate (50% marks for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B candidates) in traditional system or with a minimum 6.2 OGPA (6.0 for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B candidates) in 10 point system. **Submission of PDC/Final Transcript is obligatory with application form.**

ii) Selection of Candidates

- a) The selection of candidates shall be strictly on the basis of academic score in UG level and performance in the admission test. The academic score shall be decided on the basis of percentage of marks in aggregate or OGPA in Bachelor's degree examination. The total marks for preparation of merit list shall be 100, out of which weightage of different components of assessment shall be 30% on academic score and 70% for admission test.
- b) A common admission test for all the subjects under a faculty will be conducted. The admission test shall have one question paper consisting of 70 multiple choice objective type questions. The duration of the examination will be 1 hour 45 minutes. The total marks of the paper will be of 70 marks. Each correct MCQ question will be awarded with 1 mark and 0.25 mark will be deducted for each incorrect answer from total score. Thus, the marks obtained by the candidate will be considered as his/her actual score out of 70.
- c) The candidate shall score a minimum of 50% in aggregate of merit and admission test altogether (i.e. 50 out of 100) to qualify for admission into Postgraduate Programme.
- d) The candidates selected through ICAR all India Examination for admission to Master's Degree course shall be exempted from aforesaid selection process. However should posses the minimum qualification as stated above.

iii) Reservation (SC/ST /OBC-A/OBC-B/EWS/PwD*)

There will be reservation of seats as per existing Government rules.

*** Seats reserved for SC candidates if unfilled, will be filled up by the ST candidates and vice versa. Likewise, seats reserved for OBC-A candidates if unfilled, will be filled up by the OBC-B candidates and vice versa.

iv) In-Service Candidates

Candidates must fulfill the minimum requirement of Master's Degree Programme as stated above. However, the selection procedure shall follow the Rules as stated above. There is no separate quota for In-service candidates. 'NOC' from the employer of the In-service candidate is obligatory during the time of application.

v) Admission for enrolment

All the admission will be provisional. However, physical verification of all the relevant original documents is mandatory as per the date(s) notified for the purpose.

The candidates have to undergo medical fitness examination conducted by Medical Officer, if needed.

The admission, enrolment fees and the tuition fees paid at the time of admission are not refundable.

vi) Registration

A selected candidate after payment of his/her fees for admission shall get himself/herself registered within the prescribed date. No candidate under any circumstances shall be permitted to register himself/herself after the expiry of date or stipulated time in first and subsequent semesters as notified from time to time. He/ She has to pay the fees before registration in any semester.

vii) Cancellation of Admission

If it is found at any stage that a candidate has obtained admission by suppression or misrepresentation of facts, his/her admission shall be liable to automatic cancellation. No refund of fees will be allowed.

viii) Migration certificate

Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from Universities other than this University shall be required to produce the Migration Certificate (within the first semester of study before commencement of end-term examination) of the University from which they have passed the qualifying examination.

ix) Academic Programme

The Masters' Degree Programme shall consist of course work and research work to be carried out by the student under the guidance of an advisory committee.

x) Semester

The academic year shall have two terms known as semesters each of which shall be of six months duration. There shall be minimum 16 classes per credit for each course.

xi) Duration

Minimum 4 semesters in 2 years and maximum 10 semesters in 5 years. Students must have at least 75% attendance in each course for appearing in examination. However, five percent may be condoned by the Dean of the Faculty with the recommendation of the HOD under special circumstances.

HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION

There are Boys and Girls Hostels at Belgachia, Mohanpur and Chakgaria Campuses. Students (boys & girls) will get hostel accommodations in the respective campuses subject to the availability of seats. The allotment of seats in the hostels will be made under the instruction of Dean, Students' Welfare of the University.

LIBRARY

There is a Central Library at main campus with all modern facilities. Besides that, equally equipped libraries are situated at Mohanpur and Chakgaria campuses also.

SCHOL&RSHIP

Merit scholarships may be granted to the P.G. students as per availability and guidelines issued by State Government and University Executive Council.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO FILL UP THE APPLICATION FORM

- 1. The application form should be filled in online through University website (<u>www.wbuafsce.org</u>).
- 2. The candidate shall have to apply separately for admission to each subject.
- 3. Applicant can make the payment of application fee (Non-refundable) [Rs. 1500/-* for General, OBC-A, OBC-B & EWS and Rs. 1200/-* for Reserved Categories (SC/ST/PwD)] by Online Payment (Net-banking/ Debit card/ Credit card). [*Service charge and Applicable tax are extra].
- 4. Submission of PDC/Final Transcript is obligatory with application form during the time of application.
- 5. 'NOC' from the employer of the In-service candidate is obligatory during the time of application.
- 6. Candidates must also upload following scanned copies (colour) of their original documents in JPG/PDF format. Online Application will not be accepted unless required documents are uploaded.
 - i. Admit card of Secondary Examinations /Birth certificate as age proof.
 - ii. Final Transcript/ Mark sheets of Bachelor's Degree Examinations.
 - iii. Provisional / Final Degree Certificate of Bachelor's Degree.
 - iv. Reservation Category Certificate (wherever applicable).
 - v. NOC from the Employer (In case of In-service candidate)
 - vi. Character Certificate issued by the Dean/ Principal of the Faculty/ College last attended.
- 7. The online application received after the specified date will not be entertained.
- 8. The selected candidates will not be intimated individually. Merit list for admission in different subjects will appear in the Notice Board/ Website of the Controller of Examinations at 68, K.B. Sarani, Kolkata-700 037.
- 9. The declaration on ragging must be uploaded along with the application form in prescribed format at the time of admission.
